Travis gave the sporting Clay League report: The League has been attended by 7 to 20 shooters per week and will continue until daylight is no longer available after 5PM.

Skeet League is limited to 20 shooters and has been well attended with 16 to 19 Shooters per week. Skeet had a net income to the club of \$2,329 for the registered shoots. Good Job Steve Dodds and the rest of his crew for reviving the skeet shooting at the club!!!

Russ Huggins reported that 5 stand leagues had a great year and 5 stand leagues will resume in 2026.

Leroy reported that the club hoisted 33 corporate shoots in 2025 and financially was very supportive of the wellbeing of the club.

It was mentioned that Tuesday nights have been slower due to the leagues and members' access to the club via the card system and electronic gate.

There have been 20 members renewing their membership for 2026 to date. Membership for 2025 was around 150 members.

There was discussion regarding updating our Facebook page with events, more content and drone footage of big events.

Aaron Beitzinger: talked about the youth program and cost of coaches and registration fee \$260 that

Aaron paid and will be reimbursed from the 501 c 3. Aaron also talked about purchase of a pallet of Ammo but will gather additional information. Aaron also talked about a youth shoot in Colorado Springs next year and getting connected with Cody and SCTP club.

It was discussed and a motion was made by Leroy Meador and second by Russ Huggins to add Aaron Beitzinger and Travis Torres to the board of directors. A vote was taken and passed.

Leroy Meador mentioned that a truck load of targets will need to be ordered in April or May 2026 with an approximate cost of \$25,000. Shoot dates for 2026 will soon be provided and Saratoga will have three registered shoots in 2026. Leroy is also waiting on Cody and their dates.

Bruce Lawson: questioned the amount of money the club has spent on crushed asphalt. Discussion took place regarding why the crushed asphalt has been added to the Sporting Clay field. Leroy mentioned the main reason for the crushed asphalt is to control the dust and keep the path from eroding.

The City of Casper will donate another two loads of crushed asphalt for 2025.

Rob Myer will get the septic pumped.

Discussion was on securing the facility after the storm sewer project is completed.
